- With the motto “**Collaborate • Create • Contribute**” this Hackathon is your platform to innovate, inspire, and leave a mark.

Who Can Participate

- The CSR Hackathon 2025 is open to students of **Classes 9th–12th** from all schools.
- Each team must have exactly **4 members** – the perfect mix for collaboration and fresh ideas.



Theme of The Event

Each team will be assigned a fictional company profile (from industries like healthcare, technology, FMCG, exports, and more). The participants are expected to take on the role of a company's CSR Board of Directors. They will:

1. **Understand the Company Profile** – Study the industry, turnover, net worth, employees, and business goals.
2. **Identify Key Social Responsibilities** – Think of areas where the company can make a real social impact (education, healthcare, women empowerment, skill development, environment, rural development, etc.).
3. **Suggest Impactful CSR Initiatives** – Propose realistic and innovative CSR projects in line with the company's profile and financial strength.
4. **Pitch Like Leaders** – Present your CSR strategy as if you are the official CSR Board, justifying why your plan is impactful, feasible, and sustainable.



Event Structure - CSR Hackathon

The CSR Hackathon 2025 is a two-day immersive experience that allows students to engage with corporate social responsibility in a practical and structured manner. Participants will assume the role of CSR leaders, analyse company profiles, and design initiatives that address real societal challenges.

Day 1 – Kick-Off & Orientation

1. Distribution of fictional company profiles and Hackathon kits.
2. Analysis of the company's operations, values, and social responsibilities.
3. Initial brainstorming and development of potential CSR initiatives.

Day 2 – Proposal Development & Presentation

1. Finalization of CSR proposals with clearly defined initiatives, budgets, and anticipated social impact.
2. Formal presentation to the panel of judges within the allotted time, followed by a brief Q&A session.
3. Evaluation based on clarity, creativity, feasibility, and alignment with the company's profile.
4. This structured approach ensures that participants not only conceptualize innovative CSR strategies but also develop essential skills in research, strategic thinking, and professional communication.



Judgement Criteria

Teams participating in the CSR Hackathon 2025 will be evaluated by a panel of judges on multiple dimensions to ensure a comprehensive assessment of both creativity and practicality. The evaluation focuses on the quality of ideas, strategic alignment with the company profile, and the effectiveness of the presentation.

Teams will be assessed on:

- 1. Clarity of Thought:** Logical structuring and coherence of ideas.
- 2. Creativity & Innovation:** Originality and inventiveness of proposed CSR initiatives.
- 3. Practicality & Feasibility:** Realism and sustainability of solutions within the company's context.
- 4. Presentation Skills:** Ability to communicate ideas confidently, clearly, and persuasively.
- 5. Teamwork & Collaboration:** Effective coordination and contribution of all team members.
- 6. Adherence to Time Limits:** Completion of pitch within the allocated time.

This evaluation framework ensures that participants are recognized not only for their innovative thinking but also for their professionalism, teamwork, and strategic approach to social responsibility.



Registration Process

- **Step 1: Fill the Registration Form.**

The form QR code is give below. Complete all required details carefully and submit.

- **Step 2: Verification & Payment Instructions**

After submitting the form, our team will contact you within 24 hours for verification and share a payment reference code. Do not make any payment without this code.

- **Step 3: Payment**

Pay the registration fee of ₹1500 per participant only. Teams must make the payment under a single reference code provided by the organisers.

- **Step 4: Completion of Registration**

Registration will be considered complete only after the payment is successfully made.

- **Step 5: Confirmation**

Once payment is confirmed, participants will receive an acknowledgement mail.

General Rules and Regulations

1. Each team shall consist of 4 members, collaborating as a CSR Board, with multiple teams from the same school permitted. Independent registrations are also allowed.
2. The primary medium of communication will be English; participants may include brief vernacular expressions if relevant, but clarity and professionalism must be maintained.
3. Teams are required to research thoroughly and prepare a structured CSR proposal reflecting their assigned company's profile. All content must be original; plagiarism may result in disqualification.
4. Time Limit: Each team will have a total of 9 minutes for their presentation and 3 minutes of Q/A session. A buzzer will signal one minute remaining and the end of the allotted time. Exceeding the limit will result in penalties.
5. Participants who wish to use the projector must provide a download link to their presentation in advance
6. Participants are expected to maintain professional decorum at all times. Disrespect toward judges, organiser, or other teams, or disruptive behaviour, will not be tolerated.
7. All proposals must be aligned strictly with the assigned company profile. Any deviation or inclusion of external/unverified information may lead to scoring penalties.



General Rules and Regulations

8. Teams must coordinate internally to ensure balanced participation; all members should contribute meaningfully to research, presentation, and Q&A.
9. Use of electronic devices is allowed only for presentation purposes. **(Applicable solely upon receipt of the signed consent form).**
10. Teams are expected to report at least 15 minutes before their scheduled presentation, to ensure smooth proceedings.
11. Decisions of the judges and organizing committee are final and binding.
12. **Dress Code:** Participants should dress in a professional manner reflecting corporate decorum.

For Girls: Business formal attire such as a white or light-coloured shirt with black trousers or skirt; blazers are recommended. Minimal accessories and conservative styling are expected.

For Boys: Business formal attire including a white or light-coloured shirt with black trousers; blazers are recommended. Neat grooming and formal footwear are required.



Practical Do's & Don'ts

Do:

- Collaborate effectively with your team, ensuring every member contributes meaningfully.
- Align all CSR initiatives with your assigned company profile and resources.
- Prepare a well-structured, realistic, and measurable proposal.
- Present your ideas clearly, confidently, and professionally.
- Back your strategy with research, data, and practical examples.
- Practice beforehand to ensure smooth delivery and adherence to time limits.
- Maintain decorum, professionalism, and respect towards judges, organizers, and peers.

Don't:

- Submit ideas that are vague, unrealistic, or copied from external sources.
- Exceed the allotted presentation time.
- Let one member dominate the discussion; teamwork is essential.
- Display disruptive behavior, disrespect, or casual conduct during the event.
- Use electronic devices inappropriately or without prior approval.
- Ignore the company profile or make unsupported claims.
